

Criteria for shortlisting candidates for interview for PhD Admissions at Bose Institute, July 2020

1. Only those applications were considered where the candidate qualified (independent of the rank), one of the many national level tests that fund the student for PhD program through JRF/SRF.
2. For these candidates (who satisfied point 1) four merit lists were prepared, one each for Life Science, Physical Science, Chemical Science and Interdisciplinary Science, based on the first preference of subjects by the candidate. The merit list was based on the weightage – Class 10: 10%, Class 12: 20%, Graduation: 30%, Masters: 40%. The merit list was used to shortlist applicants for the interview. The total numbers of applicants shortlisted in each subject category was 4 times the required number of JRFs, where the reservation quota adhered to was – SC: 15%, ST: 7.5%, OBC (non creamy): 27%, DAP: 5%, EWS: 10%, unreserved: 35.5%.
